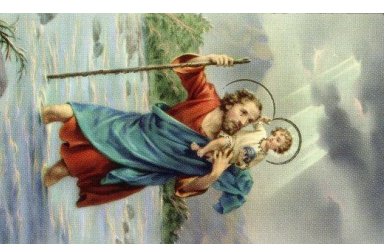

- * Receive the dividends in cash.
- * Reduce billed premium.
- * Reduce an existing loan.

Guided by the vision of our founder, Blessed Michael McGivney, we are dedicated to supporting the financial security of our members. Over the past 30 years, Knights of Columbus has paid more than \$8 billion in dividends to those we serve.

1735-1815, Carroll was born in Maryland about 15 miles east of what is now Washington, DC. In an unusual move, Pope Pius VI invited the priests in that area to choose the site of the first cathedral (Baltimore) and nominate one of their own to be their first bishop. He approved their choice of John Carroll in 1798 ("John Carroll," Catholic Encyclopedia (1908), vol. 3, p. 382).
