

For many years, it has been our Council's honor and privilege to publish a highly acclaimed and, hopefully, Informative bulletin. Each month your Council mails out 200 printed copies of our bulletin. Not only to our members but also to national and state dignitaries. However, we also send our newsletter to the widows of our departed Brothers. This is their connection to us.

....Now, we find our self in the new age of instant messaging. And, we are part of this new age. You can now download our bulletins right from your computer or smart phone.

.Now, the the question has arisen. Do we embrace this technology completely and do we do away with the printed bulletin? Or . . Keep both.

Monthly mailings of a hardcopy newsletter is expensive. Our most recent cost (printing, Non-profit mailing permit and monthly postage) costs us about \$500 per year. We were very fortunate to have had a printer (Agape Color) whose cost per month (200 bulletins, B/W) was very reasonable (\$43.07). Sadly, they have relocated and are no longer available to us. I have been pricing around and, the best I can find runs about \$100 for 200 bulletins (B/W).

So, Brothers, we need you input and, the final decision is , ultimately, yours. Until then, we will continue to issue a monthly bulletin via the electronic media.
